

71 year old, Jerry Koster of Wheatfield passed away on February 17, 2016.

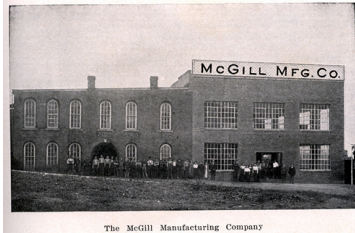
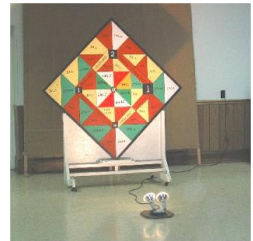
