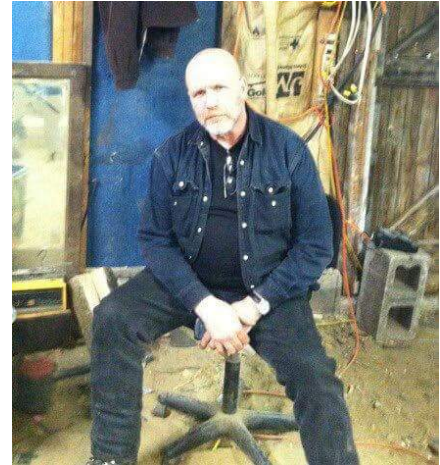


56 year old, Vincent D. 'Grit' Witkowski of Valparaiso, went home to be with the Lord on December 1, 2016.
