



81 year old, Vincent C. Hohner, of Tefft passed away September 15, 2008. He was born on January 23, 1927, in Tefft, Indiana to Martin and Catherine (nee: Rosencranz) Hohner.

On June 27, 1953, in Valparaiso, Indiana, he married Margaret O'Connor who preceded him in death November 3, 2002.
