



Richard W. Myers, age 92, passed away peacefully in his home in Wheatfield, Indiana on January 24, 2007. He was born in Riley, Indiana on December 1, 1914 to Emory Cecil and Olive Florence (Larison) Myers who preceded him in death.

On December 7, 1940, Richard married Doris B. Frame, who survives.
